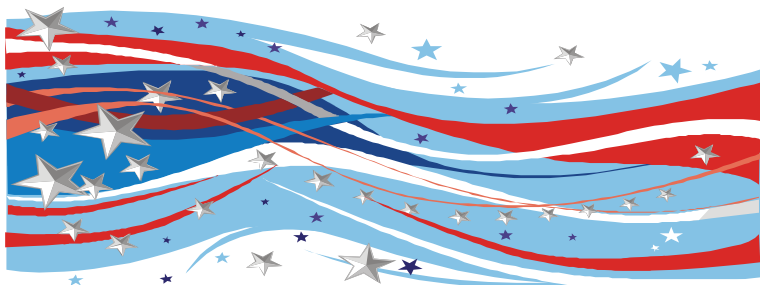

Although we are a not-for-profit organization, we are required by our club constitution to have our books audited annually. The audit for the last fiscal year was recently completed in the presence of a few key members, by an unbiased and qualified source.

After a thorough and investigation, the reported results showed that our net income for the last fiscal year was \$2,106.33. At the time of the audit (prior to payment for Ireland trip) the bank balance was \$80,285.77. In addition, both income and expenses were adequately tracked and accounted for.
