MOTION FOR CHANGE TO THE CONSTITUTION

At the general club meeting of The Sanctuary Ski Club on Wednesday, September 21, 2011, the motion was made to add Section III to Article III (Membership) of the club constitution.

Ray Piwowarczyk made the following motion:

Individual Life Membership

- A. The retiring Sanctuary President shall be presented with a life membership within sixty days of his/her retirement.
- B. The President must request this every year by filling out a membership application and submitting it to the membership chairman.
- C. Presidents who served prior to adoption of this section shall be eligible for its provisions.

This motion was seconded by Jerry Klaetsch.

****In accordance with the current constitution the following actions will take place.***

ARTICLE XI – AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION

Any motion to amend the Constitution must be made at a general meeting.

- A. Upon entrance of a valid motion, a hearing will be set for the next Executive Board meeting.

****This will be held on Thursday, October 13th.***

- B. The motion shall be published in the newsletter.

****This appears in this October 2011 edition.***

- C. The Vice President shall review the constitutionality of the new amendment and report to the membership before the vote is taken.

****This will be done by Marty Barkman, Club Parliamentarian.***

- D. A three-fourths (3/4) majority of members present at the time of voting is needed for the amendment to be adopted.

****This will happen on Wednesday, October 19th.***

- E. No amendment shall be in conflict with the By-laws.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section I Membership shall be on an individual or couple basis. A couple is defined as two people living at the same address.

Section II Any person shall be considered a member in good standing after meeting the following requirements:

- A. Be at least twenty-one years of age.
- B. Annually submit a signed and dated application and waiver.
- C. Annually pay any and all required membership dues and fees.
- D. Has not been previously expelled by the Club.

Section III Individual Life Membership

- A. The retiring Sanctuary President shall be presented with a life membership within sixty days of his/her retirement.
- B. The President must request this every year by filling out a membership application and submitting it to the membership chairman.
- C. Presidents who served prior to adoption of this section shall be eligible for its provisions.

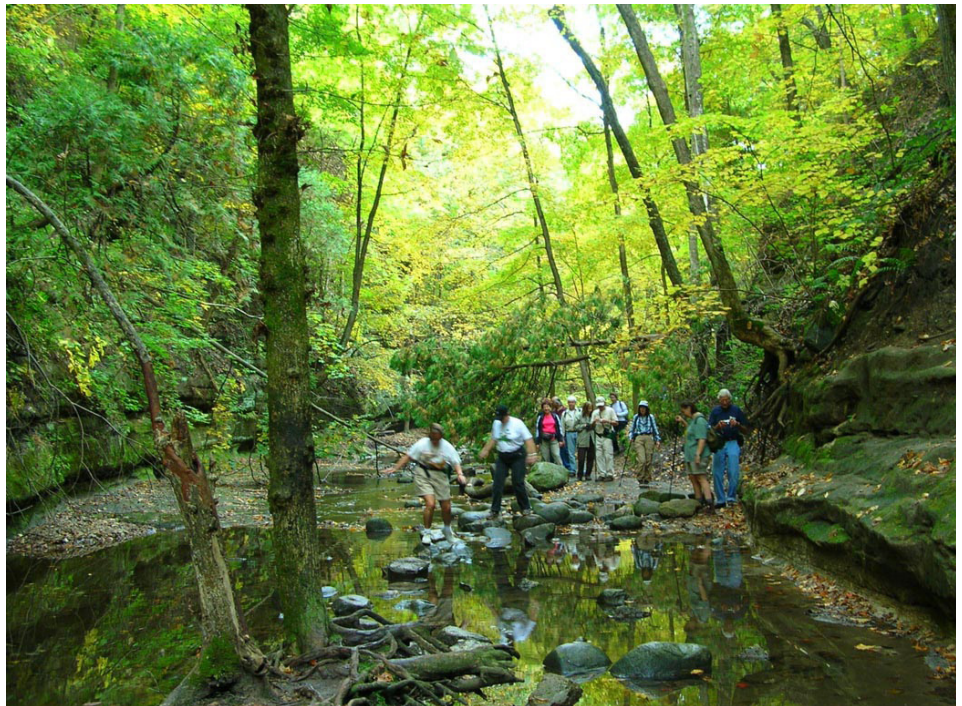

FIRST MEET FOR LUNCH AT DUFFY'S TAVERN & GRILL IN UTICA AT 11:30 AM

Directions to Duffy's in Utica:

From the Chicago area: Take I-294 or I-355 south to I-55. Take I-55 south to I-80. Go west on I-80, 45 miles to Exit #81 (Rt. 178, Utica). Left on Church St. and right on Mill St. Duffy's is at 101 Mill Street.

After lunch—at 1:00 pm—we'll meet at the Visitor's Center in Starved Rock State Park. Go south (left) 3 miles from Duffy's on Rt. 178 and follow the signs into the park.
